- 3 Increase operational area (OA) mutual aid capability through shared standards
- 4 NIMS is used to prepare for, respond to, and recover from incidents of **any** size, scope and duration
- 5 NIMS **mandates** the ICS be used for field deployment operations
- 6 Standardized, documented positions do not exist in emergency communications
- 7 The **ZR2F** is a “basic and critical” position in emergency communications
- 8 Standards of knowledge, training and experience are not documented  
Increase “**anticipated predictability**” levels in emergency communications
