South County Amateur Radio Quake Net Script

Starting a QUAKE NET:

QST. QST. QST. This is *insert your call*. This station is Net Control for the South County Amateur Radio Quake Net. At this time, south county amateurs are conducting a preliminary earthquake damage assessment where they live or work.

The purpose of this Quake Net is to standardize and make more efficient the reporting of local earthquake situation reports for all South County Emergency Management organizations. To accomplish the objective, members have been trained in advance how to report the Mike-Mike scale to minimize frequency use. If you have not already been trained, we ask for a clear frequency during all field reports.

insert your call Net Control will standby for check-ins, provide only your call sign phonetically, Mike-Mike-#, and city. Call now.

(Using QUAKE NET FIELD REPORT LOG SHEET, record call sign, Mike-Mike number, and city information.)

Responding to CHECK-Ins:

insert Calling Station Call-Sign, I copy *insert Mike-Mike-#* in *insert City*.

insert your call Net Control will standby for next station, Call now.

Periodically During QUAKE NET - per FCC every 10 minutes:

This is *insert your call* South County Quake Net Control.

Closing a QUAKE NET:

This is *insert your call*. South County Quake Net Control. This Net is now closed and the frequency is returned to normal activities. Your cooperation during the Net is appreciated.

insert your call is now clear at < 0000-hours >.

1	Not felt at all
2	Barely noticed
3	Know it was an earthquake somewhere
4	Windows, dishes rattle
5	Pictures move, doors swing, small items fall
6	Glassware broken, books off shelf, floor lamps topple
7	Furniture broken, cannot stand, chimneys fall
8	Building collapsed
G	Gas leak !
F	Fire !
I	Injury !
