## USE FOR NET when RESOURCE INFORMATION is NEEDED

*\*Before beginning the Net, check first for a clear frequency. For example you may announce:*

### *\*Start the net*

This is insert your call This station is Net Control for the Mission Viejo Emergency Amateur Radio Resource Net, affiliated with Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service (RACES) and Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES). This net is held each Tuesday evening for the purpose of establishing membership “status and availability,” training, and announcements.

Tonight’s “Training Exercise” will begin right after the announcements. Please be prepared to copy a test message using the ARES Version of the ICS-213 form.

Insert your call Net Control will now commence roll call. Please indicate you’re (A)vailable – now!, (D)elayed – for how long? or (O)ut of Service status for tonight’s Drill Incident.

*\*Proceed with traffic form, checked-in stations, and your own traffic or announcements.*
