PURPOSE: To Provide communication assistance to the City of Mission Viejo

MAJOR DUTIES:

1. To participate in weekly RACES radio net.

2. To assist with the development of emergency communication procedures, policies, manuals and plans.

During activation of RACES or an exercise:

3. To communicate messages between City Officials and other governmental agencies via the RACES network.

4. To transcribe messages received from disaster locations, shelters, schools, hospitals, other emergency operating centers.

5. Maintain a written record and log of messages sent and received.

6. To provide the City Officials with information regarding conditions in the City during and after a disaster.

7. To disseminate information bulletins issued by the Public

Information Officer to the general public.

8. To operate City packet radio (specific assignment).

REPORTS TO: RACES Radio Officer and City Emergency Preparedness Coordinator.

LOCATION: Individual assignments at various community facilities.

TIME COMMITMENT: No minimum.

SKILLS/

1. FCC Amateur Radio License.

QUALIFICATIONS: 2. Good communication skills, both written and verbal.

3. Prospective participant must possess and maintain a working amateur radio station.

4. Ability to work effectively in a stressful environment.

5. General enthusiasm and a desire to serve the City of Mission Viejo and its citizens.
